BEFORE YOU LEAVE for summer break : All students should have registered for Fall 2004 classes! Anyone taking off-campus (including regional campuses) summer courses should have CTR 5 forms approved before doing so. After completing courses send a transcript to Credit Evaluation.

DURING summer break: advisors will be in OSS over the summer to modify your fall schedule if you receive D or F grades in core science or required professional courses.

Remember that you can check SSINFO for scheduling or billing information, including deferred billing or zero balance. Fees are billed July 12 and due August 13.

All Fall 2004 Admitted Professional Students will have an orientation meeting on August 20. Put it on your calendar! PHRM 906 "Orientation" will appear on your fall schedule of classes.

ATTENTION: PRE-PHARMACY STUDENTS

Students who will be starting the Pharm D program in the fall of 2005 will experience a change in the curriculum. Beginning fall 2005, STAT 503 will **no longer** be a requirement in the curriculum. Instead, it will be incorporated into MCMP 310, and an additional credit hour will be added. You should **consider dropping** STAT 503 from your summer or fall schedule if you will be starting the Pharm D program in the fall of 2005. STAT 503 for the BSPS program, electives, or a minor will not be affected. If you have questions or concerns, please see your advisor in OSS.
