



MEDICATION SAFETY RESEARCH NETWORK OF INDIANA

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

The Medication Safety Research Network of Indiana is a voluntary organization of community pharmacies committed to advancing medication safety initiatives. The members will assist in the prevention of patient harm through the research and application of safe medication systems, processes and practices.

Member organizations will:

1. Commit to the mission of Rx-SafeNet and adhere to the policies/procedures outlined in the membership materials
2. Establish and foster relationships between all parties involved in furthering medication safety
3. Be open to opportunities to work collaboratively and synergistically to improve medication safety (e.g. active participation in research projects, contribution of new project ideas)
4. Combine expertise in considering new medication safety tools/solutions
5. Explore collaborative ways to enhance provision of safe medication systems, processes, practices across the state, using research findings to guide practice enhancement
6. Provide access to and share experts and others to assist with accomplishing medication safety initiatives
7. Share resource materials of interest to furthering the medication safety initiatives
8. Develop and provide, or actively participate in, collaborative training and education programs on medication safety and/or research conduct
9. Share information and measures intended to drive medication safety improvements.
10. Pursue collaborative implementation of new tools and processes.
11. Other subjects of mutual interest.

Member organizations will assign individuals to serve as a “site coordinator”, i.e., the point of contact, for Rx-SafeNet activities.

This is a nonbinding agreement. Any initiative or project that will require financial resources and significant people resources will be carried out through separate negotiated agreements.

Any member that wishes to disclose confidential information should only do so by establishing separate nondisclosure agreements with the other members.

A member may resign from the Medication Safety Research Network of Indiana by simply writing a letter of resignation and submitting it to the Rx-SafeNet Network Coordinator.
