You can now access BoilerConnect on your Brightspace student homepage under Campus Resources! You can meet with a variety of offices including, but not limited to:

1) Your assigned academic advisor or any advisor in the College of Pharmacy (under reason for appointment you will select "See Non-Assigned Advisor".

Students are strongly encouraged to make appointments to meet with their assigned advisor using <u>Boiler</u> <u>Connect</u>. Making an appointment via Boiler Connect ensures a dedicated mutual meeting time in which you can work with the advisor that knows you and your academic goals best.

Scheduling Tips:

Academic Advising: Meet with an Academic Advisor to discuss your courses, academic performance, personal concerns, graduate school, Pharm D admissions requirements, and questions that you do not know how to find the answer to.

Career Advising: You can speak with your Academic Advisor and we will share all we know. You can also schedule an appointment with Dr. Arnett. You can learn about Co-Ops, internships, resume/CV and cover letter writing, and interview tips and techniques.

To schedule an appointment with Ms. Martin-Murphy: Choose "Diversity Issue/Question" as the reason for your visit. If Ms. Martin-Murphy is your advisor, you can choose any reason as appropriate for the reason for your visit.

To schedule an <u>appointment with Dr. Arnett</u>: Select "Career Advising" as the reason for your visit. You can then select Dr. Arnett as the person you would like to meet with.
